



The US FIGURE SKATING Learn To Skate USA is a beginning ice skating program that is fun, challenging and rewarding. Participation in the program will enable beginning skaters of all ages to learn the fundamentals of the sport and begin a lifetime commitment to health and fitness.

Since time must be allowed for putting on skates, skaters should arrive at the rink 15 minutes before the start of the lesson. Rental skates are available free of charge. Double bladed skates cannot be used. Hockey skates may be used. Please observe the following rules: no racing or playing tag, no chewing gum, candy etc. on the ice. No digging into the ice and please obtain permission from the instructor to leave the ice.

In the event of bad weather, the Club will notify the rink by 3:00pm if lessons will be cancelled. Please call 286-1441, or check The Susquehanna Valley Figure Skating Club Facebook page. No refunds for missed lessons and no make up days will be schooled. The program concludes with a fun and exciting Recital on March 13th at 5:30pm. Skaters please arrive at usual time, but no later than 5:00pm.



BEGINNERS: SNOWPLOW SAM Levels 1-4,

Ages 4-Adult @ 4:30p-5:15p(grouped by age)

For individuals ages 4 and up who have little or no previous skating experience. Emphasis is on basic ice skating skills. The objective is to develop balance and control while skating.

INTERMEDIATE: BASIC SKILLS Levels 1-6 @ 5:15p to 6p (grouped by skill level)

Individuals must have completed Snowplow Sam or have equivalent skills. Emphasis is on development of proper skating posture and technique, forward and backward crossovers, turns and edges. <u>Hockey</u> instruction NOT available at this level.

ADVANCED//FREE SKATE Levels: Pre Free Skate, Free Skate 1 through 6 @ 6p to 6:30p Free Skate levels introduce spinning and jumping as well as complex footwork sequences.
