March 5 – Evaluation week March 12 – Party week

4:30-5:15 pm – Snowplow Sam thru Basic 6 Cost: \$70

5:15-6:00 pm – Snowplow Sam thru Basic 6 Cost: \$70

These basic classes are open to individuals **5 years** of age and older. Lower-level classes are designed to build basic ice skating skills while improving balance and control on ice. Higher levels will put an emphasis on technique and posture while improving turns and edges.

6:00-6:30 pm – Freestyle Plus Cost: \$20

Freestyle plus will be available for those students in Basic 5 & 6. This class is an opportunity for students to learn skills pertinent to figure skating. We will work on skills such as jumps, spins, gliding maneuvers, power skating, moves in the field and ice dance.

Week 9/March 5th – Evaluations:

Week 9 will be our evaluation week. The coaches will run class like a regular instructional class and will also track their students' progress on a report card that students can take home in week 10. This is not a pass/fail report; instead, it is a way for students, parents and coaches to keep track of the progress of these sessions. We hope that report cards serve as a record of students' accomplishments for the season.

Week 10/March 12 – Party:

Week 10, all classes will meet for 10-15 minutes to hand out report cards and discuss any closing thoughts or questions. Then we will celebrate a successful skating season with a free skate and pizza from 4:45-6:30pm.
